

ABOUT REPRESENTATIVE THERESA MAH

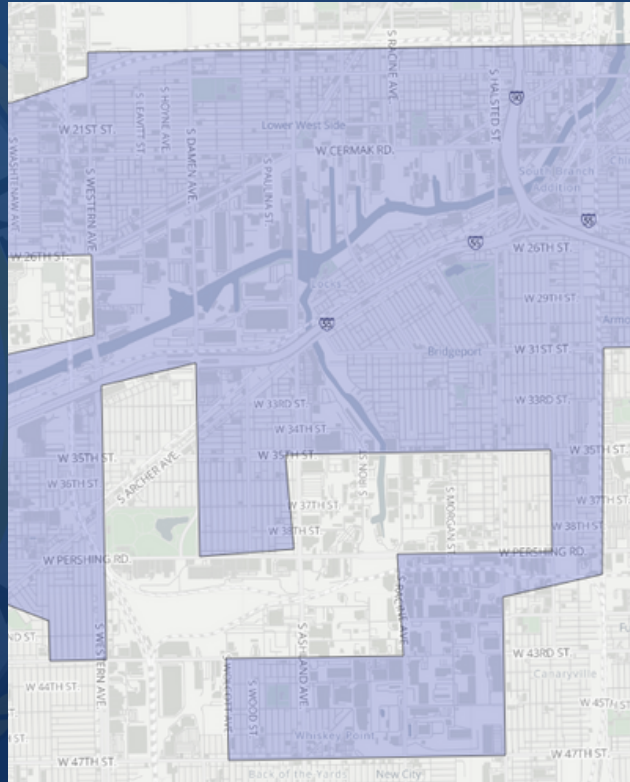

In the state legislature, Leader. Mah has been a strong champion of progressive policies that support economic opportunity, public education, environmental justice, healthcare access, affordable housing, immigrant rights, senior services, and consumer protection. As a former university professor as well as community organizer, Rep. Mah listened to and values the community's priority concern on education and safety.
